## By Tube

- Northern Line to Finchley Central (then 5 minutes walk)
- Walk up the stairs from the platform
- Turn right at the top
- Cross at the pedestrian crossing
- Turn left
- Turn right into Dollis Park
- 20 metres
- The entrance is on the left

## By Car

- From North Circular – A406:
- At Henleys Corner - turn direction of Finchley, Barnet etc (left if coming from West – M40 etc; right if from East)
- 750 metres
- Traffic lights (Queen's Head pub is at 1 o'clock)
- 400 metres
- On left just before next set of light
- We are almost immediately on the left

## Parking

On-road parking is usually available but has to be paid for at certain times of the day. Please read the signs carefully
